WHEREAS, Ken Carney, Lorain County Engineer, by letter dated October 26, 2015 submitted the following:

“We have reviewed the bids that were received for the Lear Nagle Road Widening Project in the City of North Ridgeville, Ohio. The respondents to this bid were:

Terrace Construction agrees to complete all work by October 26, 2017. They have no substitutions but will be using A & A Safety, Inc., VanCuren Services, Inc., Mt. Carmel Stabilization Group, Zenith Systems, Trafftech, Inc., The Vallejo Company, Inc., C.J. Zak Company, Inc., Ronyak Paving, Inc., and Lake Erie Construction as subcontractors for this project.

We recommend that this bid be awarded to Terrace Construction, Cleveland, Ohio in the amount of \$9,659,181.22. NOACA will be contributing \$5,769,928 and the Ohio Department of Transportation has committed \$2,412,000.00 from their safety program. The balance of the construction funding will be provided by the City of North Ridgeville.

Thank you for your cooperation with this project.”;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Lorain County Commissioners, that based upon bids received, reviewed and recommendation by the Lorain County Engineer in letter dated October 26, 2015 we do hereby award contract to Terrace Construction, Cleveland, Ohio in the amount of \$9,659,181.22 for the Lear Nagle Road Reconstruction Project in the City of North Ridgeville, Ohio.

This was the lowest and most responsive bid received and complied with all specifications.


