FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED, The Food Service Contract for the Lorain County Detention Home and Residential Facilities shall be paid from the contract service line item.


Said agreement is considered a part hereof to this resolution by reference thereto and can be found on file in the Commissioners/Purchasing and Domestic Relations Office.
