WHEREAS, Ken Carney, Lorain County Sanitary Engineer, by letter dated April 9, 2015 submitted the following:

“On April 7, 2015, bids were received by the Lorain County Sanitary Engineer for the Redfern Road Force Main Sewer Improvement #122 in Columbia Township. The respondents to this bid were as follows:

Fabrizi Trucking & Paving Co., Inc.	\$2,133,732.00
Underground Utilities, Inc.	\$2,154,719.00
DiGioia-Suburban Excavating, LLC	\$2,229,500.00
Rudzik Excavating, Inc.	\$2,833,702.64

Bids have been reviewed and the Engineer’s Office recommends that this project be awarded to Fabrizi Trucking & Paving Co., Inc., 389 Columbia Road, Valley City, Ohio 44280 in the amount of \$2,133,732.00. Fabrizi has agreed to commence work within 30 days of the Notice to Proceed and to substantially complete and ensure the system is fully operational on or before November 11, 2015.

This project is being constructed and funded through the Petition and Landowner’s Agreement adapted by the Board through Resolution No. 14-155 on March 11, 2015. Funds are currently available in Account Number 7100-7124-300-304-11-6100-6104, Redfern Capital Improvement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Lorain County Commissioners, that based upon bids received, reviewed and recommendation by the Lorain County Sanitary Engineer in letter dated April 9, 2015 we do hereby award contract to Fabrizi Trucking & Paving Co., Inc. of Valley City, Ohio in the amount of \$2,133,732.00 for the Redfern Road Force Main Sewer Improvement #122 in Columbia Township.


This was the lowest and most responsive bid received and complied with all specifications.
