WHEREAS, Ken Carney, Lorain County Engineer, by letter dated April 23, 2015 submitted the following:

“We have reviewed the bids that were received for the Wastewater System Improvements, Tanglewood Sanitary Station Rehabilitation. The respondents to this bid were:

Kelstin, Inc.	\$54,777.00
North Bay Construction	\$55,205.00

Kelstin, Inc. Shelby, Ohio proposes to begin work on or before August 24, 2015 and complete all work on or before September 30, 2015. Kelstin, Inc. does not propose any substitutions but will be using Buckeye Pumps, Galion, Ohio as subcontractors on this project.

We recommend that the contract for the Wastewater System Improvements, Tanglewood Sanitary Station Rehabilitation be awarded to Kelstin Inc., Shelby, Ohio in the amount of \$55,777.00. The Lorain County Sanitary Engineer’s estimate on the project was \$57,500.00 funds for this project are available through Sanitary Account 7100-7100-300-304-11-6380-6381, Building Repair/Maintenance.

Thank you for your cooperation with this project.”;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Lorain County Commissioners, that based upon bids received, reviewed and recommendation by the Lorain County Sanitary Engineer in letter dated April 23, 2015 we do hereby award contract to Kelstin, Inc, Shelby, Ohio in the amount of \$54,777.00 for the Wastewater System Improvements, Tanglewood Sanitary Station Rehabilitation.

This was the lowest and most responsive bid received and complied with all specifications.


