WHEREAS, Ken Carney, Lorain County Engineer, by letter dated April 14, 2015 submitted the following:

“We have reviewed the bids that were received on April 9, 2015 for the Island Road Resurfacing Project-Eaton Township. The respondents to this bid were:

Kokosing Construction proposes to begin work on or before July 27, 2015 and complete all work on or before November 1, 2015. Kokosing Construction does not propose any substitutions but will be using American Roadway Logistics, BCC Ohio and Zimmerman Paint Contractors as subcontractors on this project.

We recommend that the contract for the Island Road Resurfacing Project be awarded to Kokosing Construction, Elyria, Ohio in the amount of \$663,677.37. The Engineer’s estimate on the project was \$968,212.00. Funding for this project will be provided by the Ohio Public Works Commission (74%) and 26% local MVGT funds, Account #2580-0000-300-300-04-6100-6105, Engineering Projects.

Thank you for your cooperation with this project.”;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Lorain County Commissioners, that based upon bids received, reviewed and recommendation by the Lorain County Engineer in letter dated April 14, 2015 we do hereby award contract to Kokosing Construction of Elyria, Ohio in the amount of \$663,677.37 for the Island Road Resurfacing Project in Eaton Township.

This was the lowest and most responsive bid received and complied with all specifications.


