RESOLUTION NO. 16-741

WHEREAS, Ken Carney, Lorain County Engineer, by letter dated November 18, 2016 submitted the following:

“We have reviewed the bids that were received for the Middle Ridge Road Widening and Resurfacing project as follows:

Cross Roads Asphalt Recycling	\$ 292,544.85
Buckeye Excavating	\$ 299,717.00
Fabrizi Trucking	\$ 315,110.75
Dellinger Excavating	\$ 329,162.75
Karvo	\$ 334,495.03

Cross Roads Asphalt Recycling proposes to complete all work by October 30, 2017. Cross Roads did not propose any substitutions but will be using American Roadway Logistics for the striping and Smith Paving for the concrete portion of this project.

We recommend that the contract for the Middle Ridge Road Widening and Resurfacing project be awarded to Cross Roads Asphalt Recycling, Columbia Station, Ohio in the amount of \$292,544.85.

The Engineer’s estimated cost of this work was \$307,548.00. 80% of the funding is being provided by the Federal Highway Administration through the Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP). The remaining 20% or \$58,508.97 will be provided by the Ohio Public Works Commission.

Thank you for your cooperation with this project.”:


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Lorain County Commissioners, that based upon bids received, reviewed and recommendation by the Lorain County Engineer in letter dated November 18, 2016 we do hereby award contract to Cross Roads Asphalt Recycling, Columbia Station, Ohio in the amount of \$299,717.85 for the Middle Ridge Road Widening and Resurfacing project. This was the lowest and most responsive bid received and complied with all specifications.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that we hereby issue a Notice to Proceed letter effective on or about January 23, 2017 and work will be completed on or before October 30, 2017 for the above noted project.
