WHEREAS, Ken Carney, Lorain County Engineer, by letter dated May 24, 2016 submitted the following:

“On May 18, 2016, bids were received by the Lorain County Engineer for the Lorain County 2016 Chip and Seal Program. The 2016 program totals nearly 55 centerline miles and eleven townships are participating in this year’s bid. The respondents to this bid were as follows:

Cross Roads Asphalt Recycling	\$724,947.50
Henry W. Bergman, Inc.	\$745,242.50
Erie Blacktop	\$789,496.00
Specialized Construction	\$818,435.00

Bids have been reviewed and the Engineer’s Office recommends that this project be awarded to Cross Roads Asphalt Recycling, Inc., Columbia Station, Ohio in the amount of \$724,947.50. Cross Roads proposes to begin work on or before July 1, 2016 and complete all work by September 1, 2016. Cross Roads does not propose using any subcontractors or substitutions on this project.

County highways as part of this program estimated to be \$215,110.24 will be funded through MVGT Account #2580-0000-300-04-6100-6105 (Engineering Projects). Participating townships will be billed based on unit bid prices and the actual amount of material used. The engineer’s estimate on the project was \$824,000.00.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, we will Issue a Notice to Proceed letter as soon as possible and the work will be completed on or before September 1, 2016.
