“We have reviewed the bids that were received for the Oberlin Road Resurfacing project, Amherst Township. The respondents to this bid were:

Kokosing Construction proposes to complete all work by September 29, 2017. Kokosing does not propose any substitutions but will be using Smith Paving & Excavating; CC Ohio, Inc.; and Traff Tech as subcontractors for this project.

We recommend that the contract for the Oberlin Road Resurfacing project be awarded to Kokosing Construction, Elyria, Ohio in the amount of \$242,119.37. The Engineer’s estimate on the project was \$311,263.00.

The project includes pavement planning and resurfacing of Oberlin Road from State Route 113 to the Ohio Turnpike as well as safety improvements at the intersection of Oberlin and Middle Ridge Roads. The project was initiated as a turnpike mitigation project through the Ohio Department of Transportation.

\$98,500 is being provided by the Ohio Department of Transportation. The remaining balance shall be provided by the Ohio Public Works Commission, Amherst Township and the Lorain County Engineer, MVGT Fund, Engineering Projects Acct.

Thank you for your cooperation in this project.”;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Lorain County Commissioners, that based upon bids received, reviewed and recommendation by the Lorain County Engineer in letter dated February 17, 2017 we do hereby award contract and payment to Kokosing Construction, Elyria, Ohio in the amount of \$242,119.37 for the Oberlin Road Resurfacing Project in Amherst Township.


This was the lowest and most responsive bid received and complied with all specifications.
