WHEREAS, Ken Carney, Lorain County Engineer, by letter dated February 16, 2017 submitted the following:

“We have reviewed the bids that were received for the Baumhart Road Resurfacing project.

The respondents to this bid were:

Erie Blacktop proposes to complete all work by October 15, 2017. Erie Blacktop does not propose any substitutions but will be using American Roadway; Garcia Surveyors; Traff Tech and Welfle as subcontractors for this project.

We recommend that the contract for the Baumhart Road Resurfacing project be awarded to Erie Blacktop, Sandusky, Ohio in the amount of \$318,473.40. The Engineer’s estimate on the project was \$464,505.00.

The project includes pavement planning and resurfacing of Baumhart Road from State Route 113 to the Ohio Turnpike. The project was initiated as a turnpike mitigation project through the Ohio Department of Transportation. \$336,500 is being provided by the Ohio Department of Transportation. The remaining balance shall be provided by the Ohio Public Works Commission and the Lorain County Engineer, MVGT Fund, Engineering Projects Acct.

Thank you for your cooperation in this project.”;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Lorain County Commissioners, that based upon bids received, reviewed and recommendation by the Lorain County Engineer in letter dated February 16, 2017 we do hereby award contract and payment to Erie Blacktop, Sandusky, Ohio in the amount of \$318,473.40 for the Baumhart Road Resurfacing Project in Brownhelm and Henrietta Townships.

This was the lowest and most responsive bid received and complied with all specifications.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that we hereby issue a Notice to Proceed letter effective on or about April 1, 2017 and work will be completed on or before October 15, 2017 for the above noted project.
