WHEREAS, Ken Carney, Lorain County Engineer, by letter dated April 12, 2017 submitted the following:

“We have reviewed the bids that were received for the Jones Road (TR-5) Bridge No. 0223 & 0275 Replacement project in Wellington Township. The respondents to this bid were:

Precision Paving	\$149,639.50
Denes Concrete	\$159,293.00
Marks Construction	\$201,964.50

Precision Paving proposes to complete all work by October 31, 2017. Precision Paving does not propose any substitutions or using subcontractors for this project.

We recommend that the contract for the Jones Road (TR-5) Bridge No. 0223 & 0275 Replacement project be awarded to Precision Paving, Milan, Ohio in the amount of \$149,639.50. The Engineer’s estimate on the project was \$142,333.00.

The project includes the replacement of two deteriorated culverts on Jones Road with three sided precast concrete box culverts, along with minor roadway work on either side of the new bridges. This project has been proposed due to the existing condition of the two culverts which are actually classified as bridges as they are over a 10’ span.

The Ohio Public Works Commission will be contributing 73% of the project up to \$145,000.00 as a grant. The balance of the project funding will be provided by the Lorain County Engineer through the Engineer’s MVGT funds.

Thank you for your cooperation in this project.”;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Lorain County Commissioners, that based upon bids received, reviewed and recommendation by the Lorain County Engineer in letter dated April 13, 2017 we do hereby award contract to Precision Paving, Milan, Ohio in the amount of \$149,639.50 for the Jones Road (TR-5) Bridge No. 0223 & 0275 Replacement project in Wellington Township, Ohio.

This was the lowest and most responsive bid received and complied with all specifications.


