WHEREAS, Ken Carney, Lorain County Engineer, by letter dated November 14, 2013 submitted the following:

“Attached is a letter from K. E. McCartney & Associates pertaining to their reviews of bids received on the Griswold Road Reconstruction Project. The official bid summaries are as follows:

Fabrizi Trucking & Paving Co.	\$4,896,334.90
Underground Utilities	\$5,182,597.17
SiteTech, Inc.	\$5,746,191.72

The low bid submitted by Fabrizi is 3.3% above the Engineer’s estimate of \$4,739,888.54. They have not proposed any substitutions on the project but will be using National Light & Power as a subcontractor for the traffic signals and Precision Paving for the asphalt paving.

We recommend award of the contract to Fabrizi Trucking & Paving of Valley City, Ohio in the amount of \$4,896,334.90. The sanitary sewer costs of \$1,139,971.00 and water main upgrades of \$207,397.00 will be financed by the City of Elyria, Ohio. The balance of \$3,548,966.90 will be funded at 80% with federal funds and 20% Ohio Public Works Commission Funds.



NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Lorain County Commissioners that based upon letter dated November 14, 2013 submitted by Ken Carney, Lorain County Engineer we hereby award contract to Fabrizi Paving & Paving of Valley City, Ohio in the amount of \$4,896,334.90 for the Griswold Road Reconstruction project. The sanitary sewer costs of \$1,139,972.00 and water main upgrades of \$207,397.00 will be financed by the City of Elyria, Ohio. The balance of \$3,548,966.90 will be funded at 80% with federal funds and 20% Ohio Public Works Commission funds. .
