WHEREAS, Ken Carney, Lorain County Engineer by letter dated December 6, 2019 submitted the following:

“We have reviewed the bids that were received for the Middle Ridge Road/West Ridge Road Intersection Improvement project in Amherst Township. The respondents to this bid were:

Perk Co., Inc.	\$486,874.80
Karvo Paving	\$502,069.95
Eclipse Co. LLC	\$548,679.76

Perk Co. agrees to complete all work by July 15, 2020. They have no substitutions but will be using Lakeland Electric, Erie Blacktop, Inc., and Trafftech, Inc. as subcontractors for this project.

The project consists of adding a traffic signal at the Middle Ridge Rd / West Ridge Rd intersection, as well as adding a turn lane on West Ridge Rd. This project is being proposed due to the high number crashes at the intersection as well as the high traffic volumes being located just off of SR 2.

CEAO highway safety funds will provide 80% of project costs, up to \$391,518.74. The remaining 20%, or \$97,374.96, will be provided by the Lorain County Engineer, Account number 2580-0000-300-300-04-6100-6105.

We recommend that this bid be awarded to Perk Co., Inc. Cleveland, Ohio in the amount of \$486,874.80.

Thank you for your cooperation with this project.”;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Lorain County Commissioners, that based upon the recommendation of Lorain County Engineer in letter dated December 6, 2019 we do hereby approve and enter into contract with Perk Co, Inc., Cleveland, Ohio in an amount not to exceed \$486,874.80 for the Middle Ridge Road-West Ridge Road Intersection Improvement project in Amherst Township.

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED, that CEAO highway safety funds will provide 80% of project costs up to \$391,518.74 and the remaining 20% will be provided by the Lorain County Engineer.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that we hereby issue a Notice to Proceed letter as soon as ODOT permits and work will be completed on or before July 15, 2020 for the above noted project.
