NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Lorain County Board of Commissioners that we do and hereby award a contract to EnviroCom Construction, Inc., Beachwood, Ohio for the Lorain County Platforms & Pedestrian Bridge project – bid Package No. 1 in the amount of \$1,144,500.00. Funds are available from account # (Q Const). This contract award is dependent upon approval and completion of final agreements with Norfolk Southern and Amtrak.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a Notice to Proceed will be issued after approval and completion of final agreements with Norfolk Southern and Amtrak.


FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED, the County Administrator is hereby granted the authority to notify the County Auditor to release retainage at the completion of the contract.
