

NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Sealed proposals will be received until 2:30 P.M. on May 3rd, 2019 in the Lorain County Board of Commissioners, 4th floor, Purchasing Department, 226 Middle Avenue, Elyria, Ohio for the purchase and installation of detention grade Interior Hollow Metal Doors at the Lorain/Medina Community Based Correctional Facility located at 9892 Murray Ridge Road Elyria, Ohio 44035. All interested parties are welcome to attend the bid opening to be held immediately following the deadline, in the Lorain County Commissioners Public Hearing Room-D.

All contractors involved with this project will, to an extent practicable, use Ohio products, materials, services and labor in implementation of this project. Additionally, contractor compliance with the equal employment opportunity requirements of Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 123 is required.

Bidders must comply with the prevailing wage rates on Public Improvements in Lorain County, Ohio, as determined by the Ohio Department of Commerce, Bureau of Wage and Hour Administration, (614) 644-2239, for the purchase and installation of 65 detention grade hollow metal doors.

A mandatory pre-bid facility tour will be held on April 18th, 2019 at 9:00am at our Community Based Correction Center facility for anyone interested in bidding on this project the facility address is 9892 Murray Ridge Rd. Elyria, Ohio 44035.

Official bid documents and specifications can be obtained at the office of the Lorain County Commissioners Purchasing Department, 226 Middle Avenue, Elyria, Ohio between the hours of 8:00 A.M. and 4:00 P.M., Monday through Friday. A \$15.00, non-refundable deposit is required for each set of bidding documents. Lorain County will not accept and/or consider any bid as an official bid unless said bidder has picked up and paid for a complete bid package from the Lorain County Purchasing Department. In order to bid this project you must be a plan holder of record with the Purchasing Department. Only bids prepared on the official documents obtained from the Lorain County Commissioner's Purchasing Department will be accepted (supplemental information pertinent to the bid will be accepted as addendums). Bids must be accompanied by a Bid Guaranty and Contract Bond in accordance with Section 153.54 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Each proposal shall contain the full name or names of persons and company submitting the proposal and shall be enclosed in a sealed envelope marked “ **Detention Grade Hollow Metal Doors**”.

The Board of County Commissioners reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive any informalities or irregularities if it is deemed in the best interest of Lorain County to do so.
