Skora, Collection Center Manager for the Lorain County Solid Waste Management District developed and advertised a public request for proposals to transport, recycle and dispose of Scrap Tires accumulated by the District's Household Hazardous Waste Collection Program on September 4, 2020; and

WHEREAS, a total of two proposals were received and evaluated with WILLIG being determined to be the best suited to satisfy our requirements; and

WHEREAS, based on their proposal, we have negotiated a contract with WILLIG, and had its form and legal sufficiency approved by the Prosecutor's Office and said contract is hereby considered a part hereof to this resolution by reference thereto and can be found on file in the Commissioners/Purchasing/Solid Waste Office; and


WHEREAS it is recommended that the Lorain County Commissioners approve of this contract with WILLIG, to start in January of 2021 and continue until the end of 2023. Future contract extensions will be evaluated for 2024 and 2025.
