WHEREAS, Ken Carney, Lorain County Engineer, by letter dated May 13, 2020 submitted the following:

"We have reviewed the bids that were received for the 2020 Countywide Chip and Seal Program. The respondents to this bid were:

Crossroads Asphalt Recycling	\$647,162.50
Melway Paving	\$665,407.50
Henry Bergman	\$681,457.30
Erie Blacktop	\$716,945.00
Ronyak Paving	\$759,246.80

Crossroads Asphalt Recycling, Inc. proposes to begin work no sooner than July 1, 2020 and complete all work on or before September 15, 2020. Crossroads Asphalt will not be using any substitutions or subcontractors on this project.

We recommend that the contract for the 2020 Countywide Chip and Seal Program be awarded to Crossroads Asphalt Recycling, Inc., Columbia Station, Ohio in the amount of \$647,162.50. The Engineer's estimate on the project was \$774,366.40.

This project is being funded 100% with MVGT funds, Account #2580-0000-300-300-04-6100-6105, Engineering Projects. The County Engineer's office is to be reimbursed by the participating townships for the work performed on township roads.

Thank you for your cooperation with this project.";



BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, we will Issue a Notice to Proceed letter on or about June 1, 2020 authorizing work to begin on July 1, 2020 and the work will be completed on or before September 15, 2020.

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED, we hereby authorize the County Administrator to notify the county Auditor to release retainage at the completion of the project.
