RESOLUTION NO. 17-227

Township and the City of Oberlin, Ohio)

WHEREAS, Ken Carney, Lorain County Engineer, by letter dated March 29, 2017 submitted the following:

“We have reviewed the bids that were received for the Oberlin Road Resurfacing project in New Russia Township and the City of Oberlin, Ohio. The respondents to this bid were:

Kokosing Construction	\$788,687.25
Erie Blacktop	\$812,782.45
Chagrin Valley Paving	\$833,908.70
Crossroads Asphalt Recycling	\$839,347.45
Burton Scot Contractors	\$847,497.85
The Shelly Company	\$849,690.95
Karvo Paving	\$864,784.25

Kokosing Construction proposes to complete all work by October 31, 2017. Kokosing does not propose any substitutions but will be using American Roadway Logistics, Catts Construction and Garcia Surveyors as subcontractors for this project.

We recommend that the contract for the Oberlin Road Resurfacing project be awarded to Kokosing Construction, Elyria, Ohio in the amount of \$788,687.25. The Engineer’s estimate on the project was \$1,124,300.00.

The project includes resurfacing of Oberlin Road for approximately 3.20 miles from East College Street within the City of Oberlin to Russia Road. Construction activities include installing an aggregate berm, repairing of existing catch basins and installing new centerline monument assemblies. This project has been proposed due to the existing conditions of Oberlin Road in conjunction with it is one of the higher volume of traffic.

The Ohio Public Works Commission will be contributing 89% of the construction costs or \$582,603.27 as a grant and an additional \$119,328.38 as a loan to be repaid over a 12 year period at 0% interest. The City of Oberlin will contribute up to 15% of the local share or \$13,013.34 and have certified funds available to repay up to 15% or \$17,899.26 of the OPWC loan. Balances of the construction funding and future repayment of the OPWC loan will be provided by the Lorain County Engineer through the engineers account for roadway projects.

Thank you for your cooperation in this project.”;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Lorain County Commissioners, that based upon bids received, reviewed and recommendation by the Lorain County Engineer in letter dated March 29, 2017 we do hereby award contract to Kokosing Construction, Elyria, Ohio in the amount of \$788,687.25 for the Oberlin Road Resurfacing Project in New Russia Township and the City of Oberlin, Ohio.

This was the lowest and most responsive bid received and complied with all specifications.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that we hereby issue a Notice to Proceed letter effective on or about April 24 2017 and work will be completed on or before October 31, 2017 for the above noted project.

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED we hereby authorize the County Administrator to notify the County Auditor to release retainage at the completion of the project.
