WHEREAS, Ken Carney, Lorain County Engineer, by letter dated July 16, 2014 submitted the following:

“ We have reviewed the bids that were received for the Lorain County 2014 Chip and Seal Program. The respondents to this bid were:

Henry W. Bergman, Inc.	\$226,475.99
Erie Blacktop	\$228,179.20
Cross Roads Asphalt	\$233,232.32
Specialized Construction	\$276,516.50

Our office has not worked with Henry W. Bergman, Inc. before and a check of their references has identified issues with their performance in other Counties. Erie Blacktop has performed satisfactorily on projects for the County and we recommend award of the Contract to Erie Blacktop.

Erie Blacktop proposes to begin work on or before September 1, 2014 and complete all work on or before September 30, 2014. Erie Blacktop does not propose using any subcontractors or substitutions on this project.

We recommend that the contract for the 2014 Chip and Seal Program be awarded to Erie Blacktop of Sandusky, Ohio in the amount of \$228,179.20. The Engineer’s estimate on the project was \$221,838.00.

This project is being funded with MVGT funds available in Account #2580-0000-300-300-04-6100-6105, Engineering Projects.

Thank you for your cooperation with this project.”;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Lorain County Commissioners, that based upon the bids received and the review and recommendation by the Lorain County Engineer in letter dated July 16, 2014 we do hereby award contract to Erie Blacktop, Sandusky, Ohio in the amount of \$228,179.20 for the Lorain County 2014 Chip and Seal Program.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, we will Issue a Notice to Proceed letter as soon as possible and the work will be completed on or before September 30, 2014.
