WHEREAS, Ken Carney, Lorain County Engineer, by letter dated March 4, 2014 submitted the following:

“We have reviewed the bids on February 27, 2014 that were received for the North Ridge Road (CR-1) Roadway Relocation project in Brownhelm Township. The respondents to this bid were:

Denes Concrete	\$701,978.50
Buckeye Excavating	\$748,730.80
Nerone & Sons	\$817,754.37
Guinto Schirack, LLC.	\$837,909.90

Denes Concrete agrees to complete all work by October 31, 2014. They have no substitutions, but will be using McKinney Drilling Company for the drilling, Cuyahoga Fence for the guardrail and PSI for the traffic control portion of this project, as subcontractors.

We recommend that this bid be awarded to Denes Concrete of Wellington, Ohio in the amount of \$701,978.50. Funding for this project will be provided by an OPWC Grant in the amount of \$543,634.00 and a loan in the amount of \$178,000.00.

Thank you for your cooperation with this project.”;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Lorain County Commissioners, that based upon bids received, reviewed and recommendation by the Lorain County Engineer in letter dated March 4, 2014 we do hereby award contract to Denes Concrete, Wellington, Ohio in the amount of \$701,978.50 for the North Ridge Road (CR-1) Roadway Relocation project in Brownhelm Township. Funding for this project is provided will be provided by an OPWC Grant and Loan.

This was the lowest and most responsive bid received and complied with all specifications.


