WHEREAS, Ken Carney, Lorain County Engineer, by letter dated February 28, 2014 submitted the following:

“We have reviewed the bids that were received for the Foster Road Bridge #0144 Replacement project on February 27, 2014. The respondents to this bid were:

Denes Concrete	\$245,220.25
Schirmer Construction LLC	\$276,464.25
R & I Construction	\$310,023.40
Black Horse Bridge Construction	\$334,131.05

Denes Concrete, Wellington, Ohio agrees to commence work on or before April 1, 2014 and to complete all work on or before September 30, 2014. They have not proposed any substitutions, but will use Hart Asphalt for the Asphalt work and Cuyahoga Fence for the Guardrail portion of the project as Subcontractors.

We recommend that this bid be awarded to Denes Concrete, Wellington, Ohio in the amount of \$245,220.25. Our estimate for this was \$283,000.00. This project will be funded 89% with OPWC funds, any award should be made contingent upon the receipt of the grant and approval of the Request to Proceed. The balance of the funds will be paid from local MVGT funds, Bridge Engineering Projects Account #2580-0000-300-300-04-6100-6105.

Once we receive the approval from OPWC, we will notify the Board and the contract documents can then be signed.

Thank you for your cooperation with this project.”;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Lorain County Commissioners, that based upon bids received, reviewed and recommendation by the Lorain County Engineer in letter dated February 28, 2014 we do hereby award contract to Denes Concrete, Wellington, Ohio in the amount of \$245,220.25 for the Foster Road Bridge #0144 Replacement. The local share of this project is to be paid from Account #2580-0000-300-302-04-6100-6105 (Bridge Projects), with the balance to be paid by the Ohio Public Works Commission.

This was the lowest and most responsive bid received and complied with all specifications.


