WHEREAS, Ken Carney, Lorain County Engineer, by letter dated May 28, 2013 submitted the following:

"We have reviewed the bids that were received for the asphalt resurfacing of a 2.24 mile section of Grafton Road from State Route 57 to the Carlisle Township line in Carlisle Township. The respondents to this bid were:

Karvo Paving agrees to complete work by or before November 30, 2013. They have proposed utilizing Boca Construction, American Roadway Logistics, and Lake Erie Construction as subcontractors for this project, and no substitutions.


We recommend that this bid be awarded to Karvo Paving, Stow, Ohio in the amount of \$684,557.32. Our estimate for this was \$881,204.00. The project will be funded with 80% Federal Funds and 20% Ohio Public Works Fund.
