“We have reviewed the bids that were received for the Oberlin Avenue – Phase 2 – Part 2(A-B) Resurfacing/Waterline Replacement Project in the City of Lorain, Ohio. The respondents to this bid were:

Underground Utilities, Inc.	\$4,743,586.80
Fetchko Excavating, Inc.	4,793,220.41
Mr. Excavator, Inc.	4,968,023.30
Fabrizi Trucking	5,385,147.24
Karvo Paving Co.	5,438,502.39

Underground Utilities, Inc. agrees to complete all work by November 15, 2013. They have proposed utilizing Smith Paving, Lake Erie Construction and Oglesby Construction as subcontractors for this project.


We recommend that this bid be awarded to Underground Utilities, Inc., Monroeville, Ohio in the amount of \$4,743,586.80. Our estimate for this was \$5,667,400.00. The resurfacing component of this project (Part 2A) will be funded with 80% Federal funds and 20% local funds provided by the City of Lorain. The waterline component of this project (Part 2B) will be funded with 100% local funds provided by the City of Lorain.
