WHEREAS, Ken Carney, Lorain County Engineer by letter dated December 6, 2019 submitted the following:

"We have reviewed the bids that were received for the Oberlin-Elyria Road Resurfacing project in Carlisle and New Russia Township. The respondents to this bid were:

Karvo Companies agrees to complete all work by July 1, 2020. They have no substitutions but will be using Garcia Surveyors, Inc., American Roadway Logistics, Cuyahoga Fence LLC and BG Trucking & Construction as subcontractors for this project.

The project includes the resurfacing of Oberlin-Elyria Road for approximately 2 miles from SR 511 in New Russia Township to Butternut Ridge Rd in Carlisle Township. Construction activities also include re-waterproofing of bridge #0195, and guardrail upgrades. This project is being proposed due to the existing deteriorated condition of Oberlin-Elyria Road which is classified as a major collector due to the volume of traffic the road receives.

NOACA will be contributing 80%, of the construction costs, up to \$784,549.92. The remaining 20%, or \$143,622.90 will be provided by the Lorain County Engineer, Account number 2580-0000-300-300-04-6100-6105.

We recommend that this bid be awarded to Karvo Companies, Stow, Ohio in the amount of \$718,114.50

Thank you for your cooperation with this project.";


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Lorain County Commissioners, that based upon the recommendation of Lorain County Engineer in letter dated December 6, 2019 we do hereby approve and enter into contract with Karvo Companies, Stow, Ohio in an amount not to exceed \$718,114.50 for the Oberlin-Elyria Road Resurfacing project in Carlisle and New Russia Township.

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED that NOACA will be contributing 80% of the construction and construction engineering costs or up to \$784,549.92 with the remaining 20% provided by the Lorain County Engineer.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that we hereby issue a Notice to Proceed letter as soon as ODOT permits and work will be completed on or before July 1, 2020 for the above noted project.
