WHEREAS, bids were received and opened on Tuesday May 28, 2019 for the Regional Airport Taxiway A & B Lighting Project as follows:

J. Ranck (Mt. Pleasant, MI)	\$627,170.00	\$1,099,412.75
Perram (Wadsworth, OH)	\$397,445.85	\$795,121.95
Jess Howard (Blacklick, OH)	\$380,066.00	\$522,612.20

Richland Engineering provided the following recommendations:

On May 28, 2019, bid for the "Replacement Taxiway A & B Lighting" were received at the office of the Lorain County Commissioners Purchasing Department, publicly opened and read aloud. The Engineer's Opinion of Probable Cost is \$524,695.00.

We have reviewed the bid and tabulated the results. Jess Howard Electric Company bid amount is \$380,066.00 for the Base Bid, Alternate Bid#1 is \$20,100.80, Alternate Bid#2 is \$122,445.40, Alternate Bid#3 is \$74,095.00. The award of this amount is subject to availability of Lorain County and ODOT funds. \$496,481.59 (95% state share) will be reimbursed through the ODOT Aviation Grant for this project while \$26,130.61 (5% local share) will be funded locally for a total of \$522,612.20.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, we do and hereby award a contract to Jess Howard Electric Company, Blacklick, Ohio for the Lorain County Regional Airport Taxiway A & B Lighting project in the amount of \$522,612.20. Base Bid and Alternate Bid #1 and Alternate Bid #2. Funds are available from account 7300 0000 100 000 11 6100 0000 Capital Improvements.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all work must be completed within 180 days from the Notice to Proceed issue date.
