“We have reviewed the bids that were received for the Parsons Road Resurfacing Project in Carlisle and LaGrange Township. The respondents to this bid were:

Precision Paving	\$123,311.75
Barbicas Construction	\$128,155.70
Crossroads Asphalt	\$129,213.00
Erie Blacktop	\$141,823.05

Precision Paving agrees to complete all work by September 15, 2018. They have no substitutions but will be using Trafftech, Inc., Cleveland, Ohio and Welfle, Inc. Norwalk, Ohio as subcontractors for this project.

The project includes resurfacing Parsons Road from State Route 301 to Wheeler Road. Construction activities also include replacing roadway monuments and placing an aggregate berm. This project is being proposed as the roadway surface deteriorated quite a bit over the winter and significant repairs are needed throughout this section.

The estimated construction cost for this project is \$150,000. The project funding will be provided by the Lorain County Engineer through the Engineer's MVGT funds.

We recommend that this bid be awarded to Precision Paving Co., Milan, Ohio in the amount of \$123,311.75.

Thank you for your cooperation with this project.”;


