#1) Recycle Rex

- Grades: K-5th
- Copies: 10 (5 DVD, 5 VHS)
- Length: 10 minutes

Recycle Rex and his friends learn about Reducing, Reusing and Recycling their waste if they want to prevent their field from becoming a landfill for everyone's garbage. This is a fun and educational movie with a catchy tune to sing-a-long too!

#2) The Busy, Busy Planet

- Grades: K-12th
- Copies: 3 (3 VHS)
- Length: 11 minutes

Learn about the importance of plastics and how it can save energy.

#3) The Rotten Truth

- Grades: K-5th
- Copies: 2 (2 VHS)
- Length: 30 minutes

Stephanie talks to us about landfills, incinerators, recycling, and composting. She teaches us about the 3 R's.

#4) Let's All Recycle

- Grades: 1st-5th

- Length: 8 minutes

Jeff learns about recycling while taking out the trash. Woody Woodpecker explains it all to him.

#5) Zort Sorts: A Story about Recycling

- Grades: 1st-5th

Zort learns how to pre-cycle, recycle, and reuse garbage. He must empty all of his trash bags in order for him to return to his home planet.

#6) WALL-E

- Grades: K-12th

WALL-E (short for Waste Allocation Load Lifter Earth-Class) is a little robot with a big message about the dangers of planetary neglect. This beautiful and inspiring feature film covers important messages about environmental responsibility and offers students a vision of the future.
